Congressional Briefing on Wireless Hazards

The briefing on wireless hazards will include a screening of the new award-winning documentary film, **FULL SIGNAL**, and a discussion afterwards with experts Professor Magda Havas, Ph.D., Trent University, Canada, author of the "**BRAG™ Antenna Ranking of Schools**" report which will have just been released the morning of the 28th; Jim Turner, Esq., Chairman, Citizens for Health; Devra Davis, Ph.D., Founder, Environmental Health Trust, Professor of Preventive Medicine at Mt. Sinai Medical Center and Founder of the first Center for Environmental Oncology at the University of Pittsburgh Cancer Institute; and health advocate Camilla Rees, MBA, Founder, ElectromagneticHealth.org.

FULL SIGNAL examines the serious global health problems related to wireless technologies and the efforts of scientists, activists, lawyers and lawmakers who want antennas regulated for the sake of public health.

In this one-hour film, viewers will quickly and efficiently appreciate the emerging global public health issue related to the proliferation of wireless technologies.

Discussion and Q&A afterwards, including presentation of the findings of the "**BRAG Antenna Ranking of Schools**" report. This report grades approximately 6,000 schools in U.S. state capitals on a measure reflecting the proximity and density of nearby cell phone antennas, and it teaches how to calculate a similar measure of risk for any school, or any location, tied to the science which increasingly is showing mental, emotional and physical symptoms within 0.25 mile radius of cell phone antennas.
