The review indicates that there are no clear mechanisms for non-thermal RF effects. However, current peer-reviewed published research cited in AAEM's position paper indicates otherwise. Further, the quantum mechanism is an important mechanism of action regarding RF exposure and must be considered regarding adverse health effects.
